I realize that the House to which I am applying for residency has been established in compliance with the condition of 2036 of the Federal Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988 P.L. 100-690, and requires the house residents to (A) prohibit all residents from using any alcohol or illegal drugs, (B) expel any resident who violates such prohibition, (C) equally share household expenses including the monthly lease payment, among all residents, and (D) utilize democratic decision making within the group including inclusion in and expulsion from the group.
